### **Addendum to the Admission Policy - COVID-19 Pandemic**

Thank you for considering Pristine Private School for your child's school education.

The admission processes at PPS have been modified to accommodate the current unprecedented situation.

### **Admission Process**

Step1:

Parents are advised to visit the school website <http://www.pristineschool.com/> for the initial registration process.

Step 2:

A link to the student application form is sent that must be duly filled and submitted online with the relevant documents attached.

Step 3:

Review of the submitted application form. Students meeting the year level requirements to be scheduled for an online assessment (Auto Proctored Online Platform/Zoom/MS Teams).

### **Assessment and Admission Criteria**

FS1: The applicant would undergo a virtual screening session to evaluate the candidate's readiness to start school.

FS2 - YR2: The applicant would undergo a virtual screening session to evaluate the students' level in English and Maths.



Year 3 – Year 8: The applicant would undergo an auto proctored online assessment to evaluate his/her level in English and Maths. In the second stage, the student will be required to undergo a virtual interview.

Year 9: The applicant will take the English and Maths admission test on campus. This will be followed by a virtual interview, subject to clearing the written test.

Year 10: The applicant will take the English and Maths admission test on campus. The applicant will be required to take a Science aptitude test if the preference is Stream A. This will be followed by a virtual interview, subject to clearing the written test.

Year 11: The applicant will take the English and Maths admission test on campus. The applicant will be required to take written admission test for the preferred IGCSE key subjects. This will be followed by a virtual interview, subject to clearing the written test.

Year 12 and Year 13: Submission of their Board Results, Recommendation Letter, Previous Mock Exam results, the admission office will then review and approve the applicant for a virtual interview.

#### **Admission of Students of Determination (SODs)**

Pristine Private School offers an inclusive approach to education in line with the Dubai Law No.2 (2014) and the Executive Council Resolution No.2 (2017).

To understand the individual needs and to support SODs. the parents will be asked to email complete information regarding previous academic record and other necessary details about the candidate to determine the best possible pathway within the existing level of provision. The student will be expected to have a virtual interview.
