

UNIFORM POLICY

The uniform worn by all students must be neat and clean ensuring presentable appearance. The school uniform is made available at the school store and it should be acquired before the start of the new academic year.

The school Uniform:

Foundation Stage to IGCSE:

Boys

Half Sleeved Blue Striped Shirt
Dark Blue Shorts (FS to Year 3) and Blue trousers (Year 4 to 11)
Dark Blue Trousers
White socks and Black Leather Shoes
School Tie and black belt

Girls

Half Sleeved Blue Striped Dress (FS to Year 4)
Half Sleeved Blue Striped Shirt (Year 5 to 6)
Full Sleeved Blue Striped Shirt (Year 7 to 11)
Dark Blue Long Skirt (Year 5 and 6)
White socks and Black Shoes
School Cravat (Year3 to 11)

AS and A Levels:

Boys

Light Blue Buttoned Up Shirt
Light Grey Trousers
White socks and Black Leather Shoes

Girls

Light Blue Shirt
Light Grey Long Skirt
White socks and Black Shoes

All shirts should be buttoned up and tucked in properly. Sleeves should be kept rolled down and buttoned at the cuffs. Trousers should be belted properly at the waist and NOT be kept low.

Headwear and Hair

- Hats are not to be worn at school except for the field trips where they should be plain and simple.
- Haircuts or hair styles which draw undue attention to the wearer are not permitted. Multi – coloured or unnatural coloured hair is not allowed. Spikes and hair gel are also not permitted.
- Boys hair should be neatly trimmed to ensure that the ears and forehead is not covered. The length of the hair should not extend beyond the nape of the neck.
- Girls hair should not cover the forehead and if longer than the shoulders, it should be neatly braided.
- Girls wearing Hijabs use only plain black hijab, neatly tied and should worn meeting it's purpose
- Girls wearing Abaya should wear plain black Abaya with no adornments over the school uniform.

Cosmetics

Use of cosmetics, body paint and Nail Polish is strictly prohibited.

Permissible Jewellery for Girls

Earrings worn by girls should only be studs. No long earrings are allowed.

Any other items of jewellery such as rings, necklaces, wristbands or ankle bands are not permitted. Sunglasses are not to be worn in classrooms or offices.

Other

Mobile phones, i-pod, **Personal Digital Assistants** (PDAs) are not allowed at school. Only in the case of emergency, a mobile phone may be brought to but will have to be deposited at the office of Head of School.

However, the school does not take any responsibility for loss or damage of these items.

The possession of skateboards / skates / roller blades / scooters/and bikes and their use is prohibited at school.

Students are required to bring a school bag, relevant books, pencil case and homework diary to school each day.
